This home offers these women the ability to keep their children with them through their detox program. We have heard from one of the nurses at our local hospital, explain the program they run for victims of rape who come into the hospital for treatment. We are aware of some of the needs this program has and will work towards helping them with supplies. One of our club members attended a round table discussion about refugees in the Buffalo area. She will be reporting back to the club at a later date. At our Spring workshop in 2011 we invited Sister Kathrine, from Lockport, to speak about her missionary work in Rwanda. They need to focus on membership since realizing at 4/30 meeting that they will be losing 5 members, bringing them down to 11 for the incoming year. 1 moving to USA, 1 retired, 1 broken leg, 1 lost job, 1 resigned, 1 unsure). They have recruited a new membership sub committee but are looking for additional resources or help. I will recommend they request Zing funds if eligible, as well as establish year-long mentorship for each new member to help put them at ease in learning membership and Zonta.
