District 4 Greek "Fun" Raiser Cruise to Benefit the Amelia Earhart Fellowship:

Forty three passengers composed of Zontians from District 4, along with their families, and friends, cruised the beautiful Greek Isles this October. This was the 4th "Fun" Raising cruise sponsored by District 4 to benefit the Amelia Earhart Fellowship. The cruise departed from Venice, Italy and included the fabulous ports of Split, Croatia, Corfu, Crete, Athens, Katakolon, Santorini, and Mykonos. The cruisers were aboard Royal Caribbean's impressive *Legend of the Seas*, and enjoyed great meals, wonderful entertainment, interesting port tours, pampering spa treatments and a private AE cocktail party. The Greek cruisers from Zonta D4 contributed \$4,500. An additional donation from the Royal Caribbean cruise was added to this amount resulting in a total of \$5,400 to the Zonta International Amelia Earhart Fellowship.
