2 ungloved

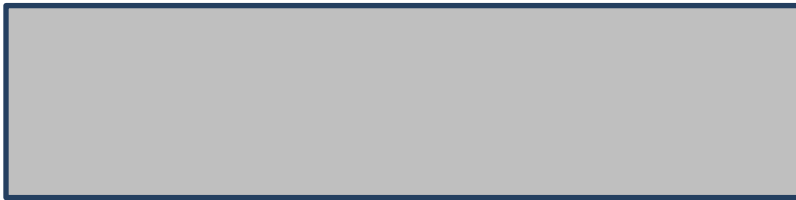
Supplies

Cutting Poly Sheeting

two long tables marked off in 3 ft lengths, covered with plastic, wiped



People

1 non-gloved handling the broom handle in the roll of poly

3 gloved to pull the poly, hold and cut the poly, deliver to container

Supplies

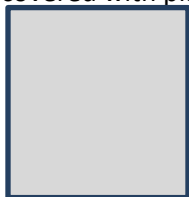
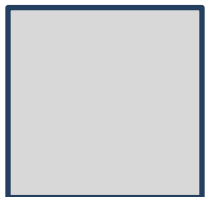
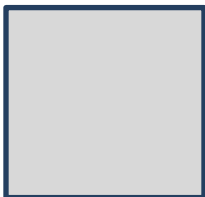
broomstick

Table taped at three foot lengths

Clothes basket wiped or lined with plastic for the cut sheets

Folding Poly Sheets



tables covered with plastic and wiped with sterile cloths

People

4 gloved

Supplies

container lined with plastic to hold folded sheets

Soap Cutting

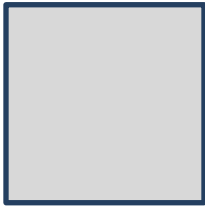


table covered with plastic and wiped with sterile cloth

Preferably is cut before assembly day and stored in cleanbag
if not, need knives and possible access to a microwave.

Persons – 3 gloved

Cutting Umbilical Cord



table covered with plastic and wiped with sterile cloth

People - 3 gloved

Supplies – 3 scissors

3 templates or 23 cm of masking tape 3 places under plastic

Assembly Table

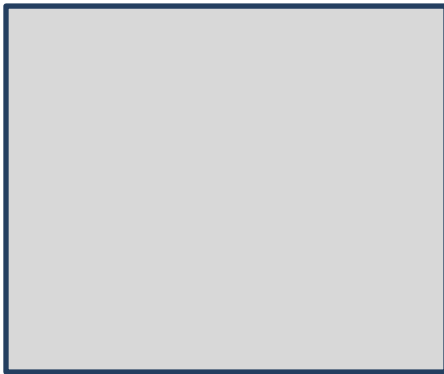


table (4 tables together) covered with plastic and wiped with sterile cloth

Persons - 8 gloved

Supplies – gauze pads, blades, soap, gloves, umbilical cord

Quality Control



People – 2 non-gloved

Supplies – ten empty copy paper boxes

Tasks – replenishing supplies to assembly table

- holding bag to be filled by gloved person with poly sheet then items from assembly table then carried to quality control table

Supplies – straws , masking tape to label bottles
