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General Information

The Z Clubs and Golden Z Clubs are part of Zonta International's service projects. Z Clubs and Golden Z Clubs are organizations which provide opportunities for our youth to develop leadership skills, explore career alternatives, and improve international understanding through service projects and advocacy. The Z Clubs and Golden Z Clubs are our "**Future Leaders Building a Better Future through Service and Advocacy**". Zonta International District 4, has created this opportunity for Z Clubs and Golden Z Clubs to demonstrate their leadership and commitment to service and advocacy. To be considered, each applicant is required to complete this application form based on the following criteria as listed below.

The Award

This award is funded by **District 4** to recognize and honor the service work of individual Z and Golden Z Clubs, and individual members of those clubs for their outstanding leadership in the mission of Zonta. This award is currently funded at **\$250.00 US** for each category as set out below. **Awards will be presented at the District Conference which is scheduled to take place in Buffalo, New York on September 26-29, 2019.**

Who is Eligible?

Any chartered Z Club or Golden Z Club, and any individual Z Club member, or Golden Z Club member.

What are the Requirements?

Applicants must meet the following minimum requirements:

- □ Your club **must** complete an **Emma Conlon Award** Application.
- Knowledge of Zonta International and its goals.
- Evidence of active commitment to Z Clubs or Golden Z Clubs.
- Evidence of leadership through your club.
- Demonstrate how Zonta benefits you as an individual.

How Do I Apply?

- Completion of an official application which can be downloaded from the District 4 website <u>http://zontadistrict4.org/?page_id=20</u> or from your teacher advisor.
- All applications and supporting information becomes the property of District 4 who has final authority over all aspects of the awards.
- Only supporting documentation that is requested will be considered.

What is the Application Process?

- The review panel will select one winning entry in each category, and notification will be sent to the winning applicants.
- A monetary gift as stated above, and a certificate will be presented to each winner at the **District 4 Conference which is scheduled in Buffalo, New York, September 26-29, 2019.**
