District 4 Centennial Traveling Flag
Signature Instructions

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.

ONLY use the pens included to write on the flag. If you need more, please contact Janice Durmis, Lt. Governor.

Club Presidents will sign their name and club. Please follow directions and DO NOT write anywhere else on the flag. Ex. Janice Durmis, Erie.

Signing starts at the top right-hand corner and proceeds clockwise around the perimeter. If a second line of signatures is needed, please proceed in the same way beginning at the right hand corner and moving clockwise.

The top and bottom signature lines are upright.

The signatures on the two sides have the tops of the writing toward the outside and bottoms toward the inside of the flag.

The best way to keep the signatures in line is to place the blue painter's tape included on the flag just below the one-inch line so you can use it as a guide to sign.

After signing remove the blue painter's tape.
