Fundraising	Successful Zonta Classic Golf Tournament held in June Two bingo sessions per month all year, each with 2 members attending	Successful outcome with close to \$6,000 raised to support mental health programs for women.  The bingo participation brings in an average of \$1200 per each session. The majority of members are trained to work these sessions.
Awards	YWPA 2020 has been advertised.  Project Achieve info was mailed to all high schools in Brampton and Caledon	All 9 Z Clubs will receive the YWPA packages and be encouraged by the assigned member liaison to participate.  To date, 10 schools have responded requesting the award and members have gone to the school award ceremonies to give out in person.
Advocacy	Members participated at the Enroute location on Hwy 400 on the Int. Day to End Trafficking media and advocacy.  In partnership with the PRLC, we hosted an All-Party Debate at Brampton City Hall prior to the Federal Election.	Although not organized by Zonta, there was an invitation to participate/advocate and it also provided an opportunity for the traveling flag to be displayed.  Successful first-time partnership with new organization and opportunity for greater visibility in the community and awareness amongst candidates.
