Criteria for Service Project	90% development of Service project checklist for clubs & service committees. Distribution was made in February 2019.	Announcements at D4 Conference encouraged clubs to pursue "Hands-On" Service Projects and to communicate their projects with ADs and Service Committee. Encourage clubs to continue to notify service chairs of their projects. (A cc: is fine.)
Communication with clubs on current status of local service projects	Develop a survey for members to learn more about service projects clubs are engaged in.	Encourage participation. Many Clubs have service chairs for specific projects. Hoping to get an overview from some clubs we previously missed by sending it to all D4 members.
Service Communications (New website)	Promote & highlight club service activities and projects. List of birthing kit materials ZI Service Recognition Award information Community Partnerships: Centennial Anniversary Grant	The Service Pages will continue to be updated. Advise clubs ZI will not solicit new nominations for Service Recognition Awards. They will choose from nominations received for the Centennial Grant program for the 2020 Convention.
Birthing Kits	Most of the US kits have been shipped.	Continuing to pursue information for shipments. UN Medical Women International may be doing another shipment soon. Will contact us. Many clubs reported numbers at the Conference. Over 12,000 were shipped in the 1 <sup>st</sup> year of the biennium.
Birthing Kit Assembly	Several Canadian clubs joined together for bulk purchasing. Nita McCown (AD3) is the contact for additional information	Several Canadian Clubs purchased supplies in bulk. Will continue to pursue resources. Many are donated especially gloves and gauze. Clubs are beginning to schedule Assembly Dates in 2020.
Free the Girls	Project was discussed at the workshops.	Many clubs have collected bras for this program. Moratorium for Canadian Clubs while Free the Girls pursues non-profit status. We will update clubs as information is received.

		Many US Clubs are involved with this project making it a hands-on project by having a Packaging & Shipping Party. (Warren Club) Over 2700 bras have been shipped.
